

## NCLB PARENTAL NOTIFICATION

The No Child Left Behind Law (NCLB) requires that Title I schools must notify parents that parents have the right to have their child taught by highly qualified teachers. Under NCLB, the Commonwealth has identified a highly qualified teacher as one who holds a valid teaching certificate for the area(s) or subject(s) currently taught.

Under NCLB, parents also have the right to review the qualifications of their child's teacher(s) and Title I para-professionals. To do this, parent(s) are asked to call the Superintendent's Office to make an appointment to review their child's teacher's certificate.
