“BATH SALTS” ALERT!

1. **WHAT ARE THEY**

Bath Salts are stimulant designer drugs whose effects mimic methamphetamine and cocaine use and they have a high risk of abuse and overdose.

2. **WHAT ARE THE PRIMARY CHEMICAL INGREDIENTS IN BATH SALTS?**

MDPV (methylenedioxypropylvalene) – powerful stimulant found in ecstasy

Mephedrone – a powerful stimulant

- Snorted
- Injected
- Eaten
- Smoked

4. **HOW MUCH DO THEY SELL FOR?**

Approximately \$30 - \$40 for ½ to 1 gram

Psychological

Delusions
Hallucinations
Extreme Paranoia
Delirium
Potential For Violent Behavior
Behavior Similar To A Psychotic Break
Suicidal Behavior
Can provoke an almost uncontrollable urge for another hit

Physical

Rapid Heartbeat
Elevation In Blood Pressure
Agitation
Extreme Anxiety
Burst of Energy
Insomnia
Potential For Heart Attack, Stroke, and Death

7. **HOW LONG CAN SYMPTOMS LAST?**

Symptoms of bath salt use can last for more than 10 days.
