

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT**

Please be advised all students eligible for transportation must be assigned to a bus. If your child is not on the driver's roster he/she will not be allowed to ride that bus. If you have moved please contact your child's school immediately, so that a new bus can be assigned and your address can be updated in our computer system. Buses, stops and times are the same as when we started school in September.

### **Due to COVID-19 we are asking students to strongly adhere to the following bus rules:**

1. All students must wear a mask the entire time they are on the school bus, unless they have a medical exemption approved by the school district. Bandannas and neck gators are not allowed.
2. Students must sanitize their hands prior to boarding the school bus.
3. Students must socially distance at their bus stop, when getting off the bus in the Morning, and when boarding the bus after school.
4. Students must ride their assigned bus. All students will have assigned seats and must sit in the same seat every day.
5. Students from the same household must sit together on the bus (2 to a seat).
6. Students will not be allowed to change buses. **NO bus passes will be issued.**
7. Parents/guardians/caregivers are required to perform a symptom screening on their children prior to arriving at bus stop each day.
8. **Parents are strongly encouraged to transport their children to and from school if possible.**

**Disclaimer:** Please be advised that it is a parent's/guardian's decision to put your child on a bus or van. We cannot guarantee a complete germ-free environment. Waiting at the bus stop and riding the bus pose a risk similar to going to a restaurant, movies, or the grocery store, etc. Your child will come into contact with other students. If you do not feel it is safe for your child, then you are certainly at liberty to drive or walk your child to school and we strongly encourage this if possible. The choice and responsibility are yours.
