Level 1

- Kindergarten Orientation: All incoming registered students are invited to attend an orientation session at the school. Parents will be informed of academic expectations, school regulations and policies, Positive Behavior Intervention & Support (PBIS) program, nutrition programs, etc. Students will have an opportunity to explore the classrooms, participate in educational activities, practice riding the bus, and experience a treat in the cafeteria.
